What's the difference between combined 'combi' sessions and the classes?

In our **combined sessions**, students work through our maths and English materials at their own pace. Supervised by our diligent tutors in a ratio of four students to every tutor, our combi sessions are designed to be a perfect compliment to classroom learning. Topics across the national curriculum are reinforced in a nurturing environment and key literacy skills including comprehension, creative writing, grammar and punctuation and numeracy skills including number, shapes and space, geometry, algebra and equations.

In our **classes**, students work in a small group, progressing through the curriculum week by week. Students benefit from the depth that each topic is explored within the class. They are challenged by their peers and have the opportunity to build confidence and share their ideas with the group. These intensive classes are tailored towards a specific goal, whether it be acing the 11+ exam, reaching the top of a secondary class, preparing for SATS exams, or perfecting handwriting.

Can I reschedule the sessions I've chosen?

What happens if I miss a session?
